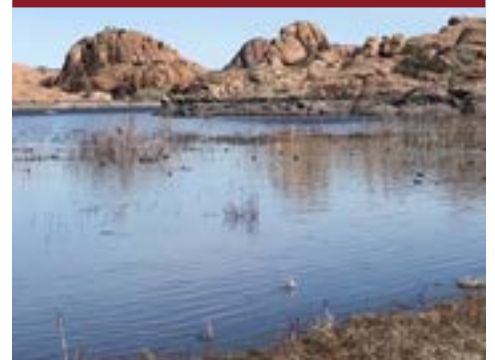
LIVING HISTORY
